<u>Scales</u>

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E major two octaves - separate bows and slurred in fours F# major two octaves - separate bows and slurred in fours Ab major two octaves - separate bows and slurred in fours E harmonic **OR** melodic minor two octaves - separate bows and slurred in fours A harmonic **OR** melodic minor two octaves - separate bows and slurred in fours F Lydian mode two octaves - separate bows and pizzicato

Arpeggios

E major two octaves - separate bows and slurred in threes F# major two octaves - separate bows and slurred in threes Ab major two octaves - separate bows and slurred in threes E minor two octaves - separate bows and slurred in threes A minor two octaves - separate bows and slurred in threes

Chromatic scale

on G two octaves - separate bows and slurred in fours

<u>Dominant 7th</u> in Bb major two octaves - separate bows and slurred in pairs

Diminished 7th on F two octaves - separate bows and slurred in pairs
