Section 1

Scales, arpeggios & chords from memory (10 marks)

For the examination the Candidate should be asked to perform <u>all</u> of the following scales, arpeggios and chords from memory.

Scales D major – two octaves, hands together, swing rhythm G harmonic minor – two octaves, hands together Chromatic starting on D, two octaves, hands separately

Arpeggios Bb major – two octaves, hands separately B minor – two octaves, hands separately

Chords (To be played with the left hand, full-fingered) G minor in root position, 1st and 2nd inversions D7 in root position
