Technical Section (Prepare all 3 sections)

Section 1

Scales, arpeggios & chords from memory (10 marks)

For the examination the Candidate should be asked to perform <u>all</u> of the following scales, arpeggios and chords from memory.

Scales

A major – two octaves, hands together

Eb major – two octaves, hands together

C blues – two octaves, right hand only, swing rhythm

Arpeggios

Eb major – two octaves, hands together

F# minor – two octaves, hands together

Chords

(To be played with the left hand, full-fingered) C minor – root position, 1st & 2nd inversions

Cm7 - root position, 1st, 2nd & 3rd inversions

Section 2

Technical exercises (10 marks)

^{*}Make at least 3 expressive changes such as voice change/dual, fill, dynamic contrast.

^{**}Use dual for vocals. Fill at second double bar. Crescendo towards third double bar.
