For the examination the Candidate should be asked to perform all of the following scales and arpeggios from memory. Play each scale and arpeggio tongued or slurred (as requested by the teacher/examiner)

<u>Scales</u> Majors: Eb & F (two octaves) & A (12th) Minors D (two octaves) & F# (12th) (harmonic or melodic)

<u>Arpeggios</u> Majors: Eb (two octaves) & A (12th) Minors D (two octaves) & F# (12th)

<u>Chromatic scale</u> Starting on F (one octave)

Option 2 – Alternative to scales from memory

Instead of learning the scales and arpeggios from memory candidates may prepare all the scales and arpeggios listed in option 1 **with the music**, using the appropriate articulations and rhythms for this level which can be downloaded from the website – see <u>MTB Option 2 – Alternative to Scales and arpeggios from</u> <u>memory</u> sheet.
