# **Scales**

Majors: Eb & F (two octaves) & A (12th)

Minors D (two octaves) & F# (12th) (harmonic or melodic)

#### **Arpeggios**

Majors: Eb (two octaves) & A (12th) Minors D (two octaves) & F# (12th)

## Chromatic scale

Starting on F (one octave)

## Option 2 – Alternative to scales from memory
