Then, I shall ask you to sing an ascending minor triad, after I give you the starting note again.






Test 2 - Intervals.

I will play a note and ask you to sing a specific interval above. We shall do this for 3 different intervals.






1. Major 3rd 2. Minor 7th 3. Minor 3rd

I shall play a 2 note interval and then you will sing the higher and lower note.


We shall do this 4 times.







Candidates should practise the six clapping exercises below as part of their preparation to take this grade.
