## Advice for Candidates with Special or Different Learning Needs (SEND)

Therefore, the learner is free to utilise any necessary aids or support they require meaning that many of the difficulties of accessibility are overcome without any special dispensation or adjustment being required to the qualification itself.

You will be asked to provide the following information:

- Learner's name, instrument and grade
- MTB Exams reference number (only if the exam has already been entered)
- The nature of, and rationale for, the request
- Any supporting information/evidence (e.g. medical evidence or a statement from the teacher or any other appropriate information)

Once we receive your application for a Reasonable Adjustment, we aim to respond to you with a decision within 10 working days.
